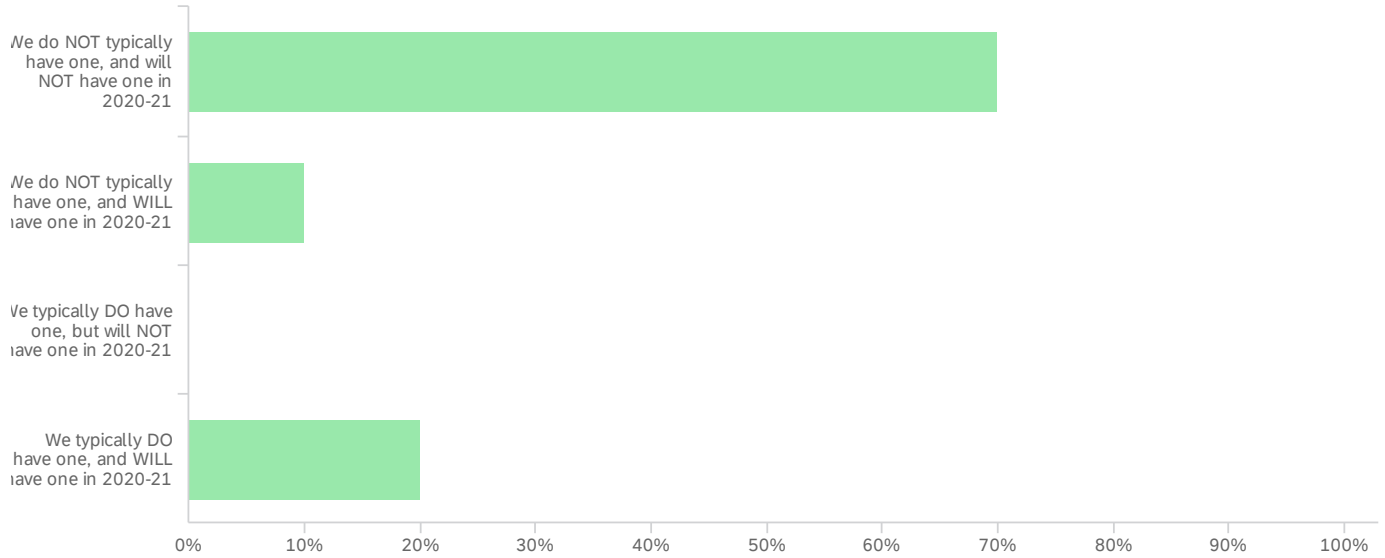

What is your institution's plan for a winter session or January term?

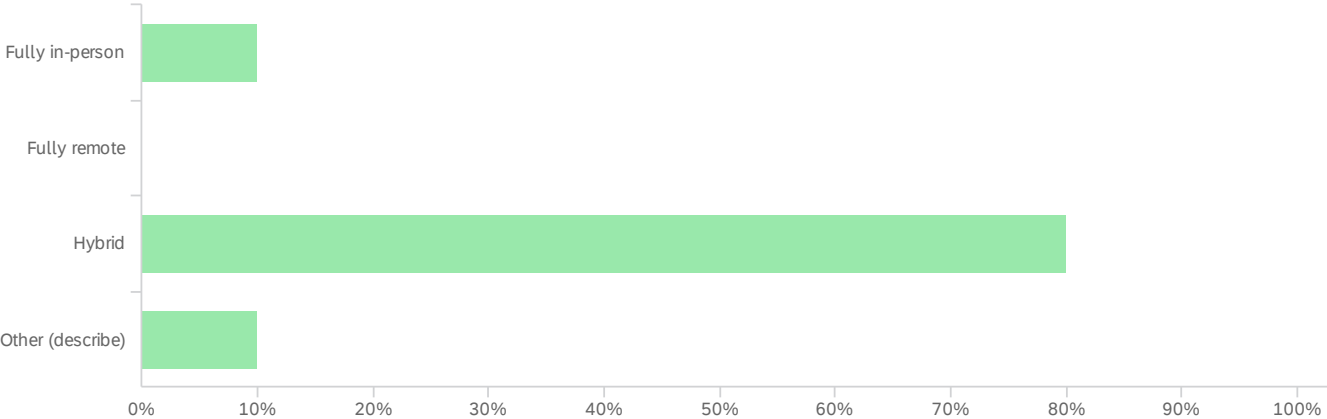

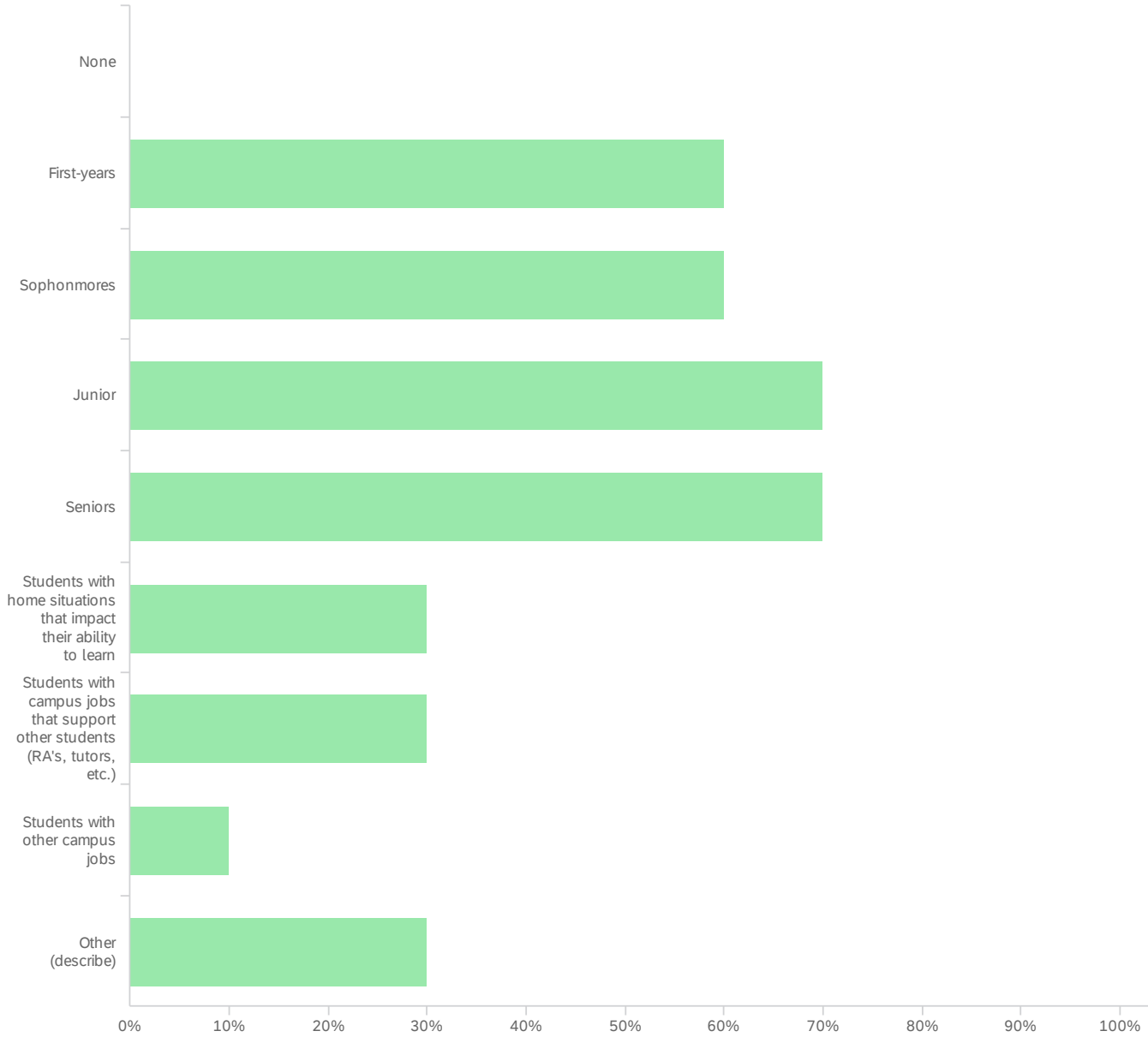

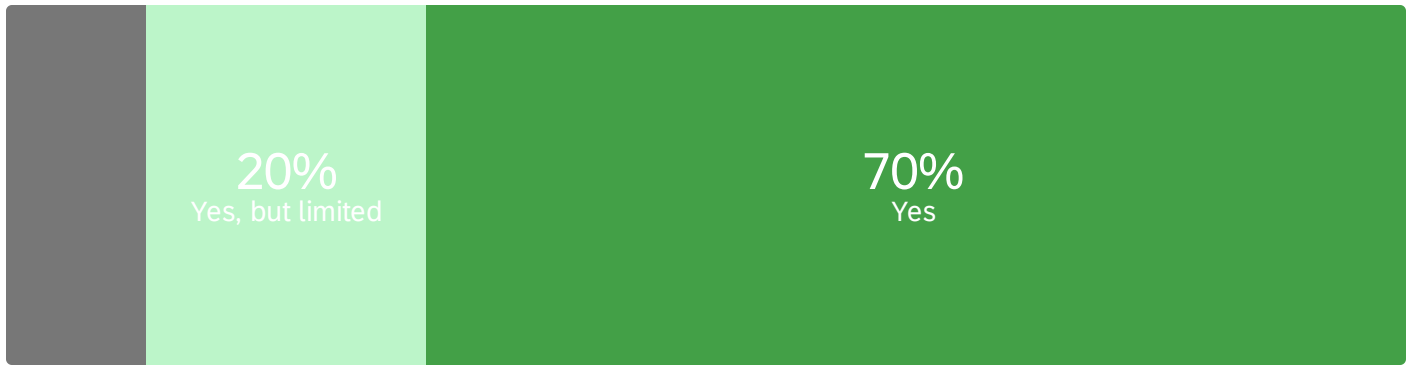

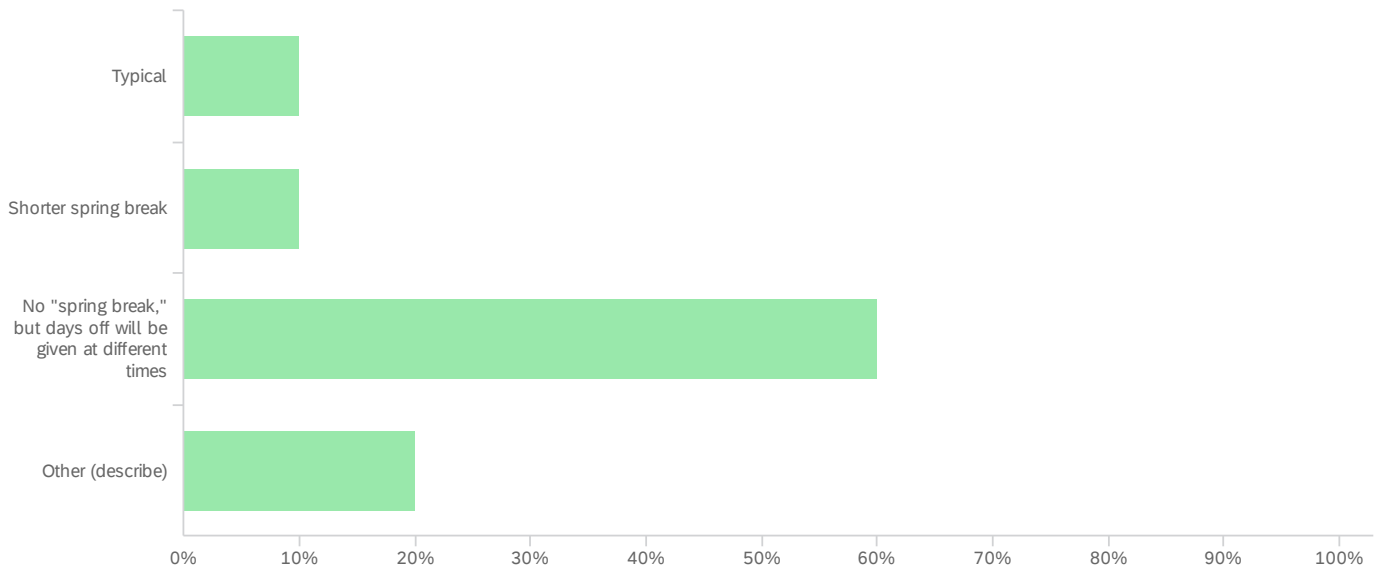

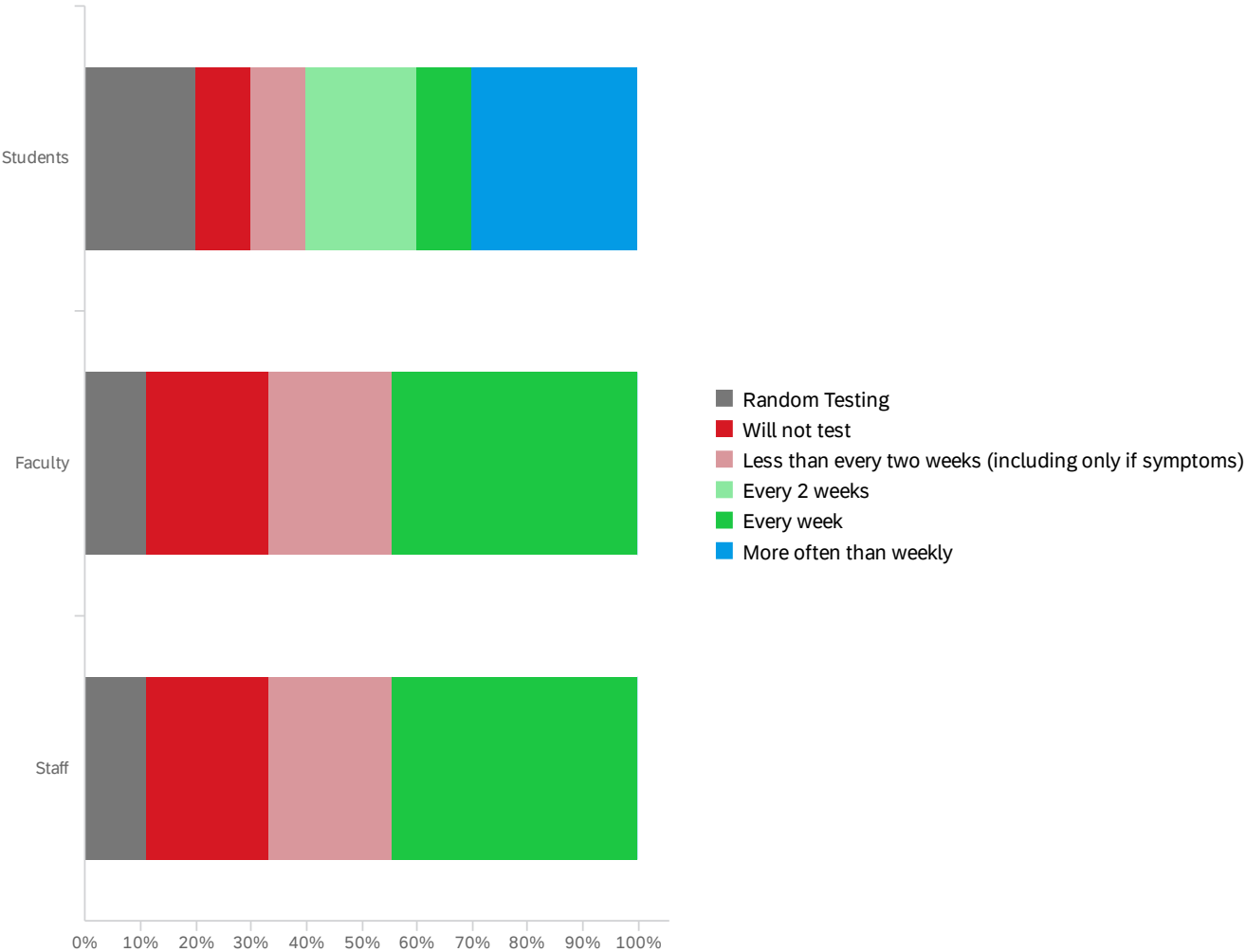

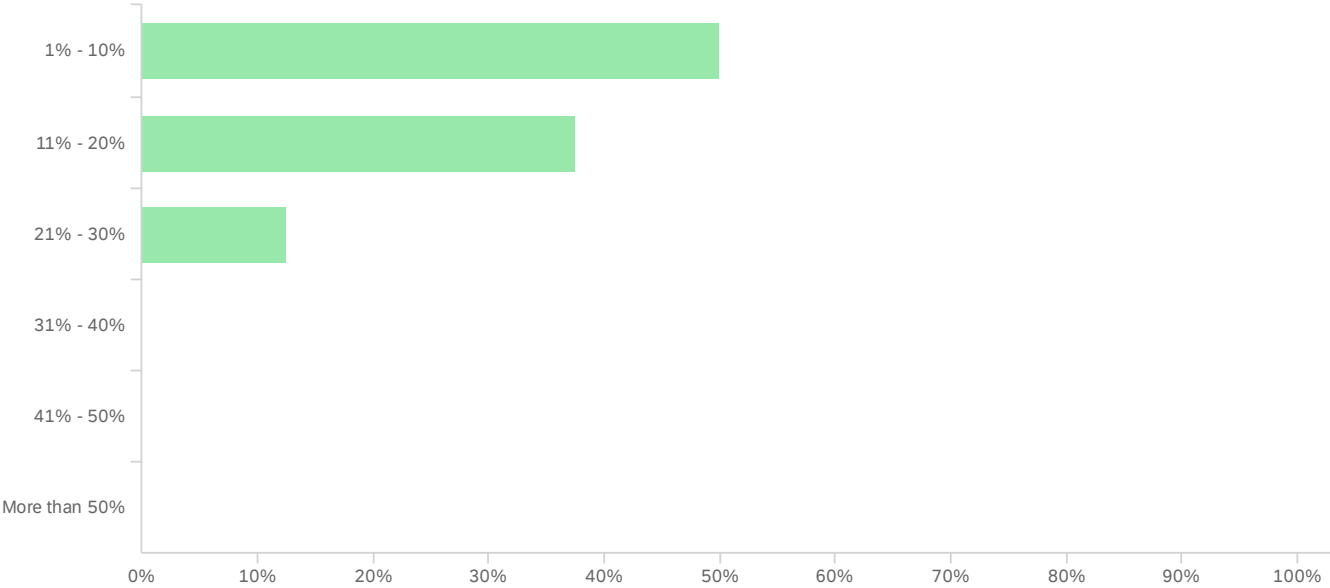

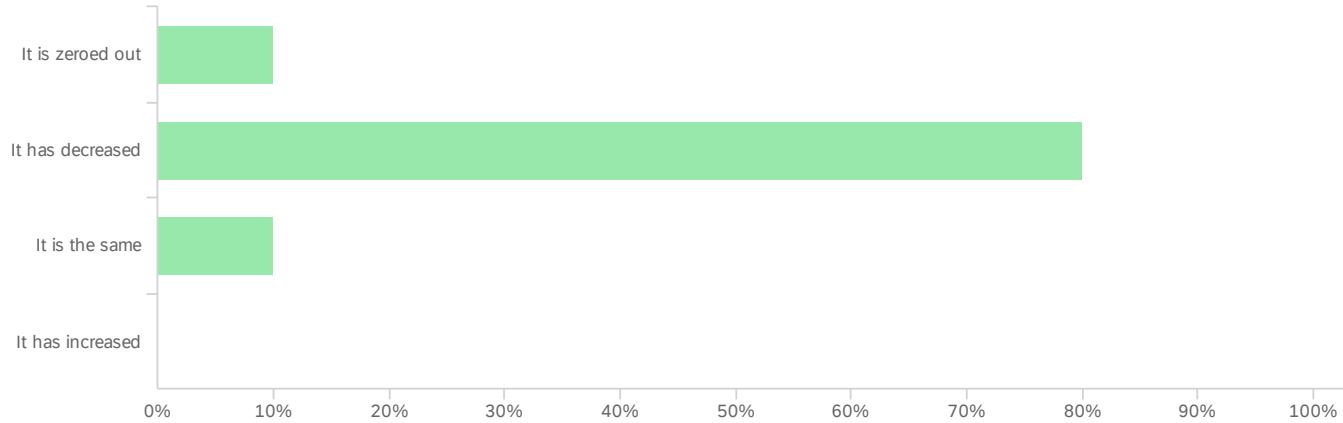

How does your institution's capital expenditure this year compare to FY 2019-20?

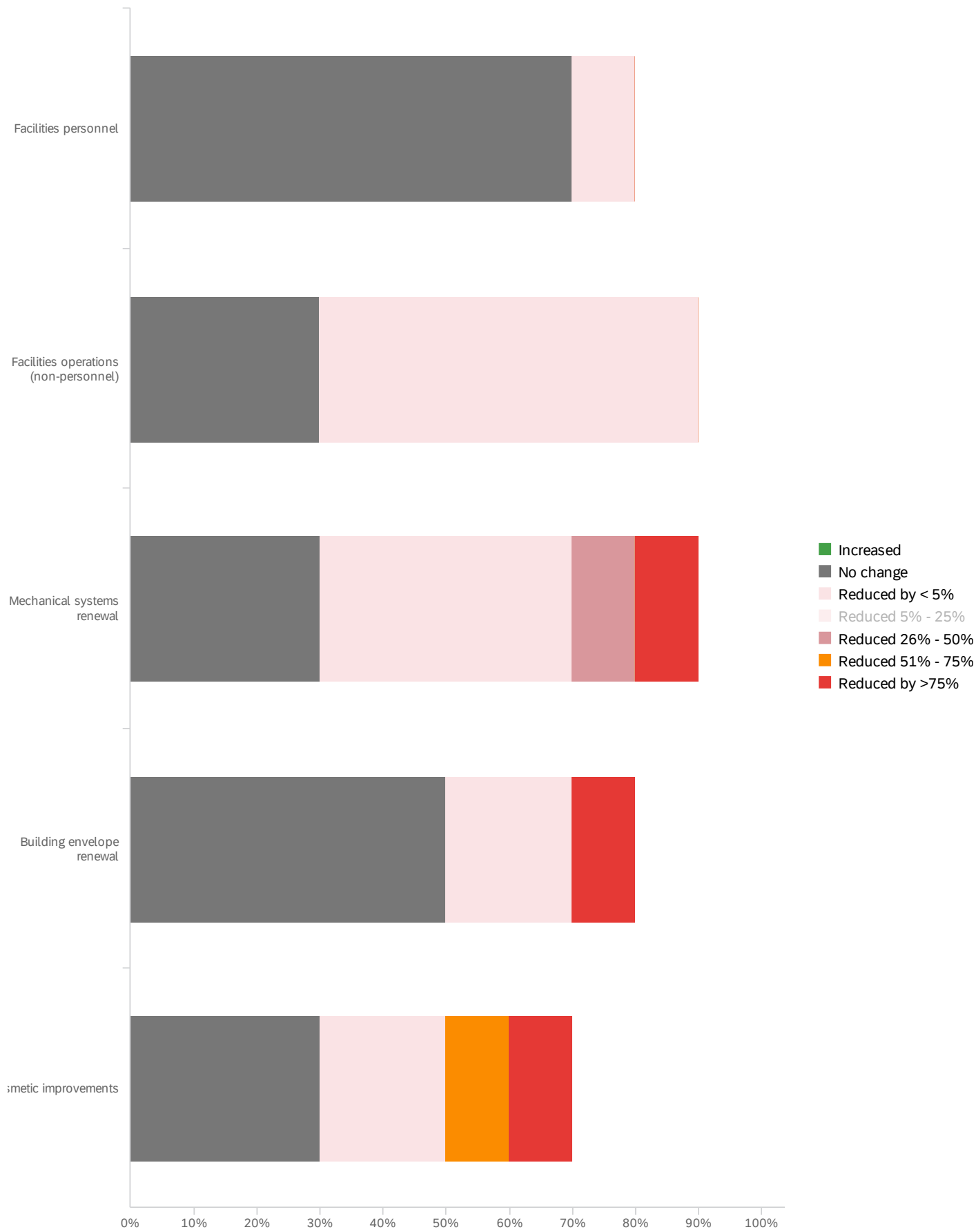

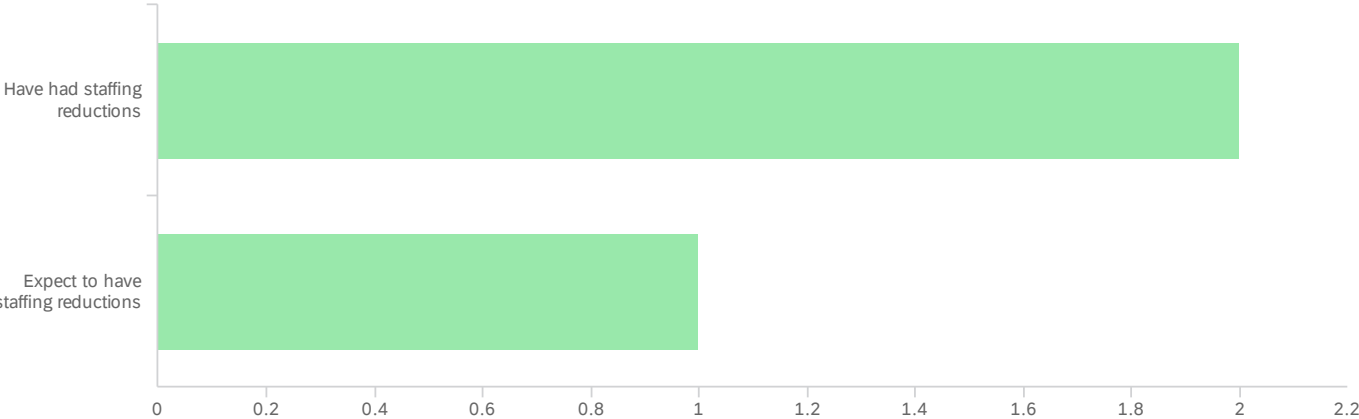

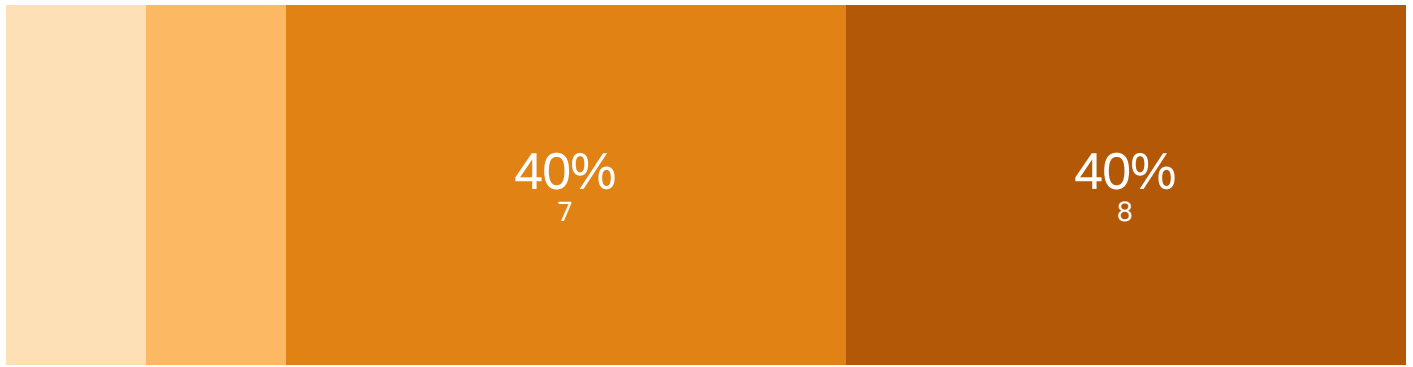

How would you rate the value of virtual conferences/training vs in-person conferen...

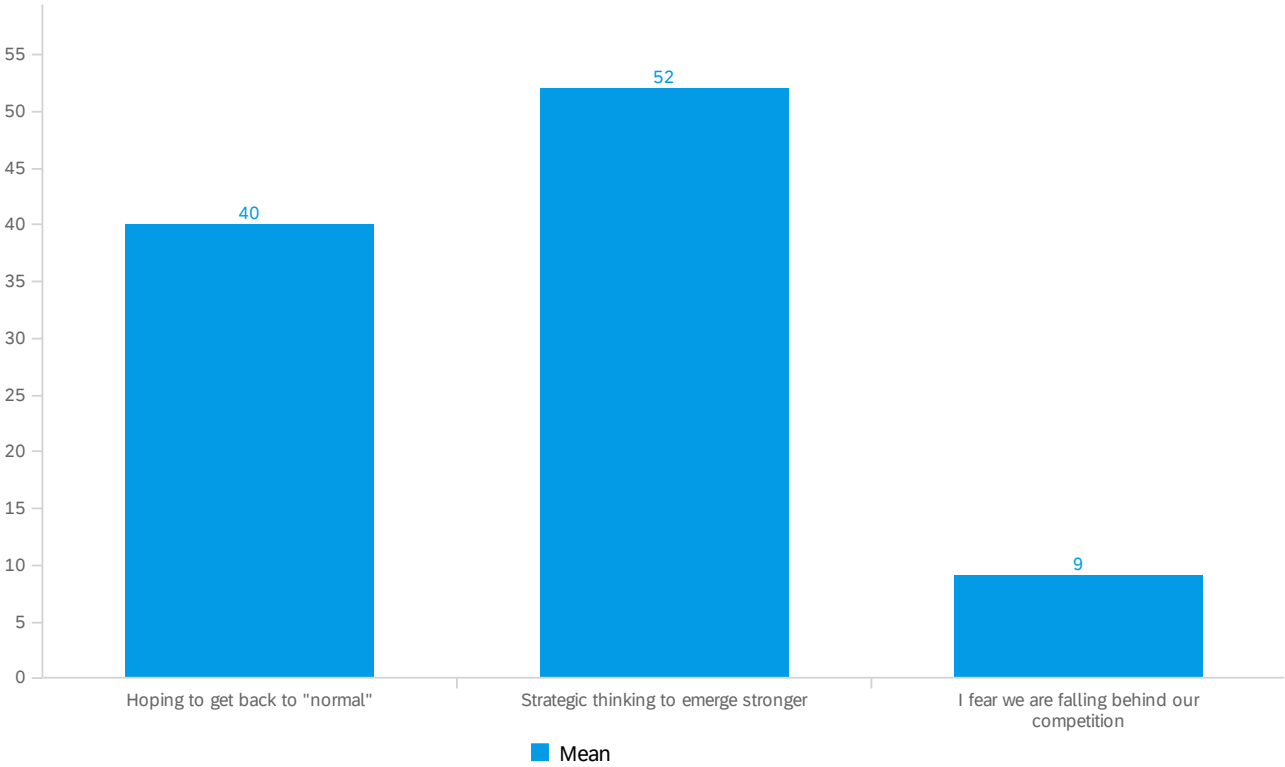

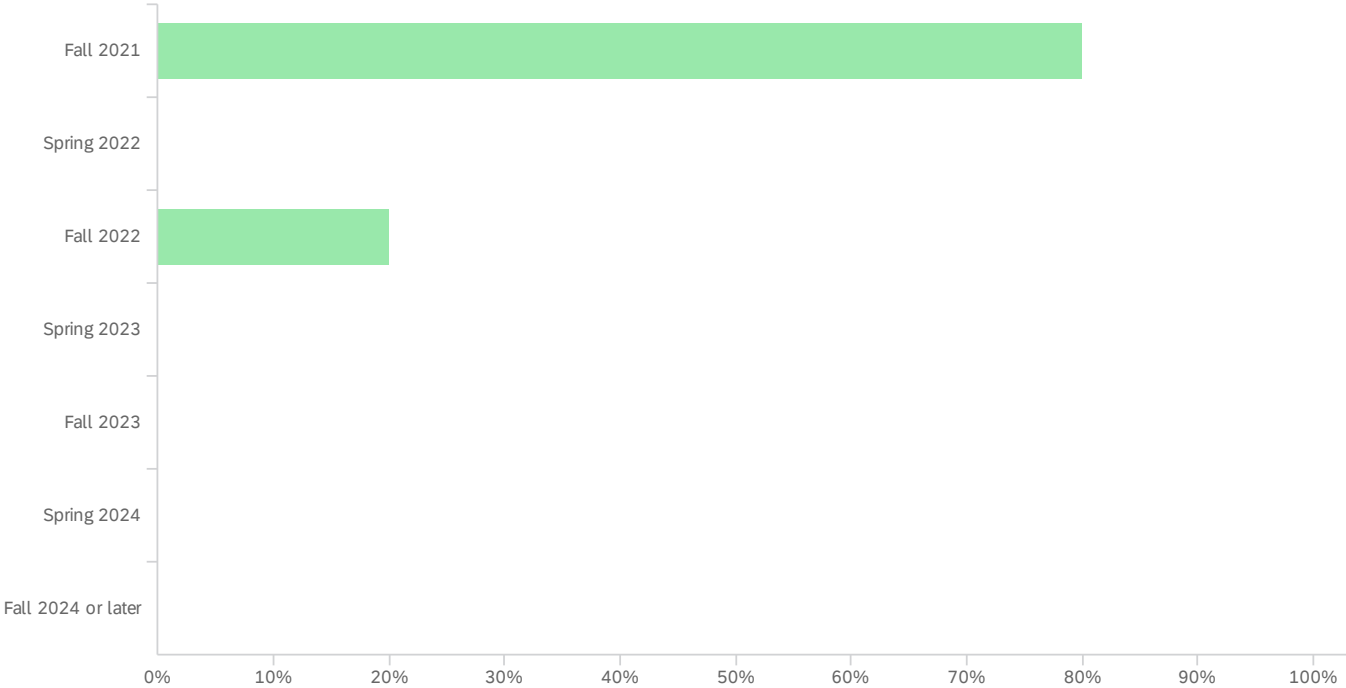
